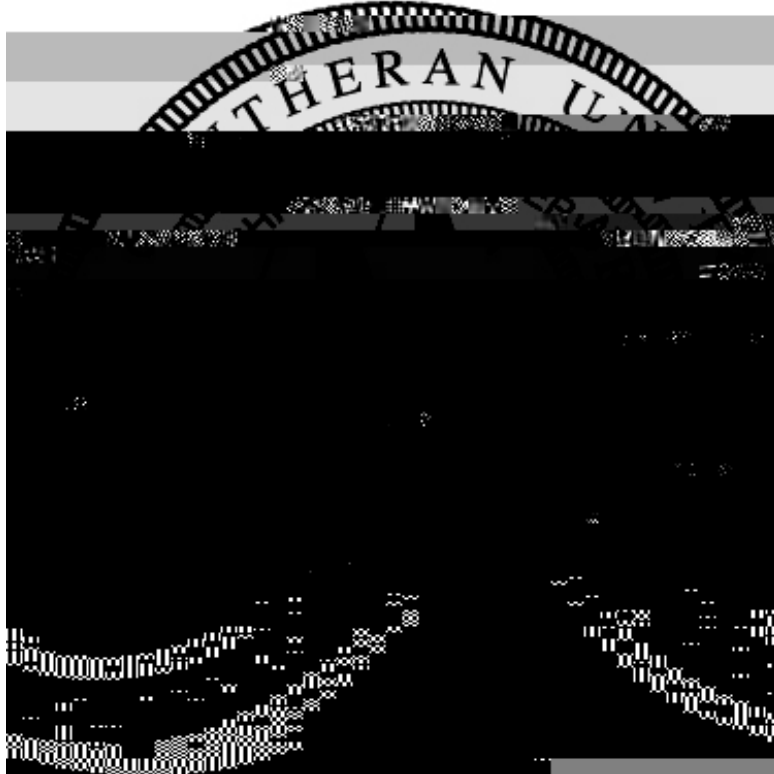

No more than 2 courses from any single discipline or from the modern languages can count toward this requirement.
- x Natural Sciences & Math
6 hours from the following: NSCI 140, BIOL, CHEM, CSCI, ENVS, MATH, PHYS, STAT
At least one course must be a natural science course taken with a lab.
- x Social Sciences
6 hours from the following: SSC1130, CRCJ, ECON, GEOG, POLS, PSYC, SOCI

The Competencies

Through completion of the foundation and distribution courses listed above, and also through selected courses in their majors, students will be developing important competencies. Course offerings designed to meet each competency will be identified in the schedule of classes with a competency code attached to the course number. Students will be required to take courses with the following competencies:

- x Critical Thinking (T): 3 courses
- x Effective Communication (C): 2 courses
- x Engaged Citizenship (Z): 3 courses
- x Ethics (E): 1 course

COCR 227.01 – (F2F)

Race, Identity, and STEM

This module will allow students to explore the intersections of race, identity, and STEM. Students will be asked to read selections from *We Could Not Fail: The First African Americans in the Space Program* by Richard Paul and Steven Moss, and *Path to the Stars: My Journey From Girl Scout to Rocket Scientist* by Sylvia Acevedo. Through in class discussions and written responses, students will be asked to contemplate what it means to be scientists or mathematicians in predominantly white fields. In addition, we explore intersections of various other marginalized identities in STEM fields. Focusing on the Z competency, this module will also ask students to map their various cultural, social, and personal identities with input from their families and exploring their histories. Specifically, they will be asked to create five content-inspired journal entries for each workshop that culminate in the creation of an identity map and the presentation of artifacts that connect their personal/social/cultural identities with their goal STEM identity as a way to empower them in their STEM journeys. Workshops and outside research will engage students with their communities of support inside and outside of their chosen STEM fields, including conversations with family systems and STEM mentors, where they will explore the different ways that their various identities inform each other and provide avenues for success particularly as it relates to STEM fields.
